Dear Anna E. Damn -

Here is a postal order - the Postman will show you how to sign it - or if you take it to Mrs. Sweet - she will show you how to do it - or she will pay you the money on it \$9.60 - then you pay Ma Margaret & yourself as faræ it goes - and tell me - really you are entitled to two weeks pay - but make out the bill & send me hers.

Sister Mary has not come yet - from Duluth - its hotter than blazes here - 94° in the shade yesterday --- So keep cool, I say, and do all of your sewing and patching up - the next letter will tell when we are coming home - I think.

Maude is bright & hopping around like a cricket - Love to you & Margaret - and Genevieve - when she calls - - S. B. A.
