Leavenworth, Kansas, June 12,1901.

Brother D. R. & I went to the Maple Leaf station yesterday to see if sister Mary had come - but she did not put in an appearance - But this - Thursday A. M. - brings this Postal-card - which shows we shall meet her this noon - I do not know when she will think best to start for home - but brother D. R. thinks I had better go to Fort Scott - the tickets wont be here until tomorrow - so I cant go before Saturday - Maria Anthony - will - I hope - have her papers there - so that I can close up her trade with Mich byers - & shall try & sell her McLean house - and lots: of other things -

The weather has turned cooler yesterday - it is very pleasant now - I hope you are getting along all right - Does Margaret say anything about going to Canada? I sent you in two different envelopes new different P. O. orders - for \$15.60 (?) better write here - you doubtless have written to Duluth.

I have received two registered letters from Rochester - they were sent to Minneapolis first and then here - I have had no letters from Rochester - either direct or forwarded - since coming here - I left word at Minneapolis to have my letters all forwarded here - so guess there is nothing to come - Well - do the best you can - I shall expect fo find you all sewed up & mended up - so you will be nice as a pin -
