Chicago, June 20, 1901 -

Dear Anna Dann

We arrived at 1.40 P. M. yesterday - found Cousin Hannah & Katie Boyles - and Cousin Jessie Anthony of California here with Cousin Melissa - So after a 6 dinner I came over to Mrs. Gross & slept - and this A. M. have had my head nicely washed and my switch also - until all look clean & nice - and now I go to the Walton - to dine at 12 and 3 o clock - we all go out to Lake Geneva - to cousin Hannah Boyles! - Mrs. Gross wants me to come in Saturday A. M. & go to the Darby races with her - She will take her niece Minnie & husband - Mr. Collins - and her other niece - and we then will occupy the back seat of her Landaus - her very fine carriage - I do not know if Mary will stay on - but think she might as well now - to please all round - Will be at Chicago far toward home - and when we shall get there I cannot now tell - The weather is very much cooler here than it was in Kansas - the broad & beautiful lake is in front of the house & the drive is beautiful - for very quiet for almost every one is gone to the sea shore -

I hope you & Margaret are well & strong. Well I trust every thing is going on all right.
