Dear Anna,

We are just going to start for New Orleans – We take the 11:15 -- train on the Southern r. Way -- via Atlanta, Montgomery & Mobile – I haven't looked at the papers to see how the floods are – but it seems good to think I have you to look after the mail & see that nothing drops while I am gone – You got home from Albion last night -- I hope you found all well & right on our return --
