I have put your bundle in Mrs. Harpers trunk – and locked & strapped it – and it has gone to the Depot with mine -- and I have my <u>ticket</u> and going to leave on the Northern Central -- tomorrow – Saturday A.M. at 6.50 – So I shall be on the way southward by the time you are up – I shall go to the Shoreham Hotel – Washington DC. – I cannot tell how long I shall stay there – I am going to stop at Miss Shaws – 7443 Devon (?) -- for several days so that I shall be gone over a week anyway –

Here is a slip about feeding babies – I trust you will be careful about changing your darlings food too suddenly –

The Ocident – or should it have been two C's – is very beautiful – tell Charlotte I am going to read it on the cars tomorrow – and show it to Mrs. Harper -- Charlotte has done well as an editor – if looks tell the story – [page 2]

I trust she will keep her <u>head level</u> – that is the <u>great question</u> – with bright girls – well love to the baby & to Gilbert --& you & Charlotte – Love
