Yours of the 14th from Washington to Col. Bartlett was sent to me this morning.

The order accepting the resignation of your Commission I forwarded to you at Fortress Monroe. The application was sent on at once and came back unusually soon.

Your papers were sent to your address "General Hospital, Fortress Monroe [?]" We are across the Chickahoming – and look for a fight in a day or two.
