General Orders # 2

Until further orders commanders will each day cause four companies of their commands to practice firing at a target with ball cartridges. Two companies will practice in the morning and will be excused from Brigade Drill, and two will practice in the afternoon and will be excused from battalion or company drill. The practice will first be by man at 200 yards and a record will be kept of the distance of each mans shot from the centre of the target then by sections at 300 yards then by platoons at 400 yards and then by company at 500 yards. All company officers "present for duty" will be required to be present with their companies during the whole time of practice and they will be required to be present with their companies during the whole time of practice so inform themselves, and will instruct their men with such care that all may receive correct notions of the true principles of Rifle-firing Company commanders will see that sentinels
