(ELEPHAS PRIMIGENIUS, BLUM.)

The great Siberian Mammoth: whose remains were found, in the year 1799, frozen in the ice banks at the mouth of the river Lena, in Siberia. The skeleton now stands in the Museum of the Imperial Academy of St. Petersburg. This restoration is made from bones of a larger individual in the Royal Museum of Stuttgart, Wirtemberg.
