







MAPLE GROVE FARM.







RESIDENCE AND FARM OF JOHN BUCK, WINDSOR TWP. MORGAN CO. OHIO.





Dr. J. W. White, who is well worthy of mention as a prominent citizen of Morgan County, remained as such until 1854, when he withdrew to become 1st Master of Webb Lodge, No. 252 (instituted at Stockport October 18, 1854), serving in that capacity for several years with "honor to who were well-to-do farmers, removed to Windsor township, this county, in the year 1825, locating to himself and credit to the fraternity," remaining zealously attached to the order until his death, which occurred February 2d, 1875. His funeral, which was conducted under the auspices of the order, was largely attended, many prominent Masons of the county participating in the ceremonies. he became a member of the Masonic order at Corinthian Lodge No. 111, McConnellsville, diate vicinity.
