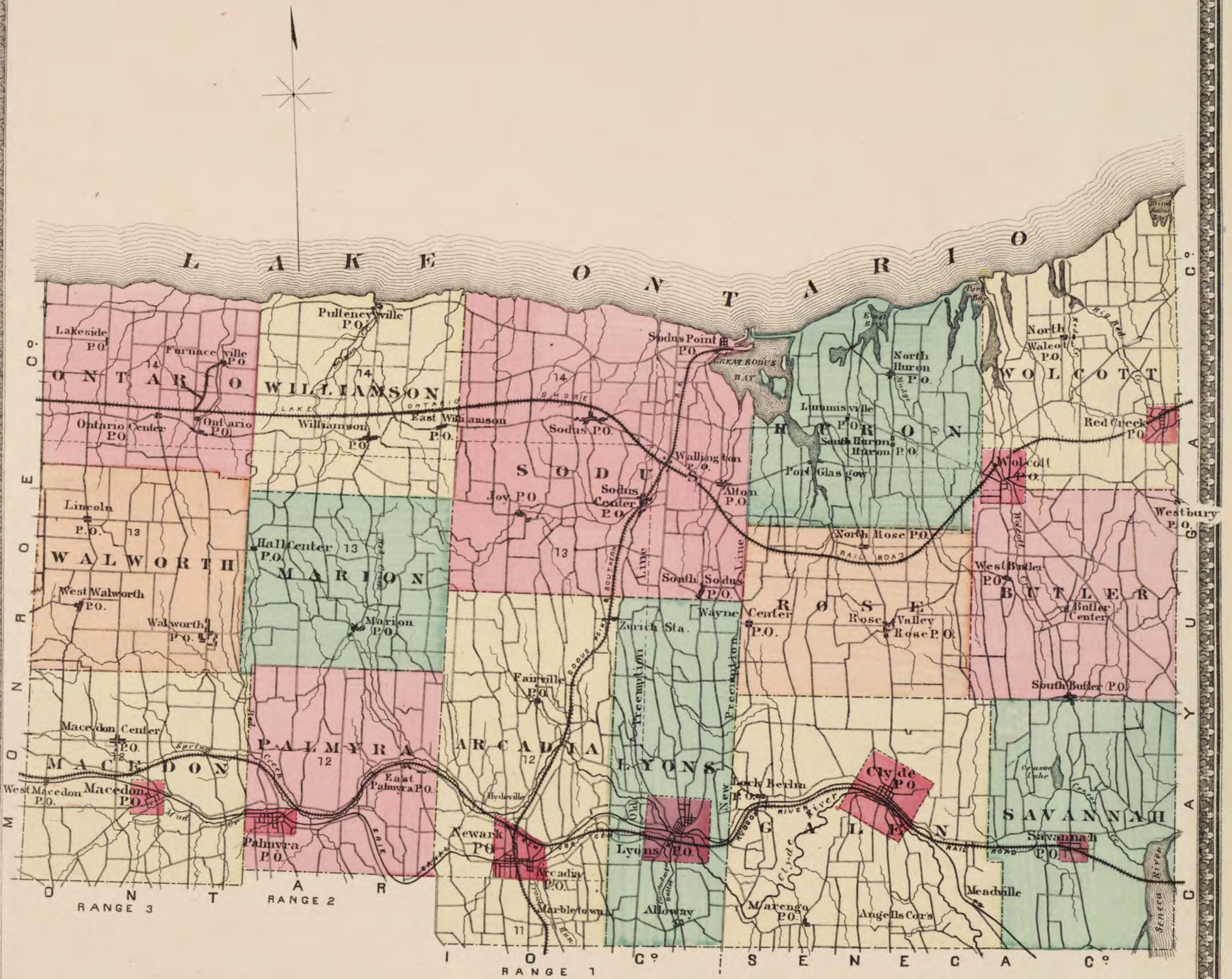

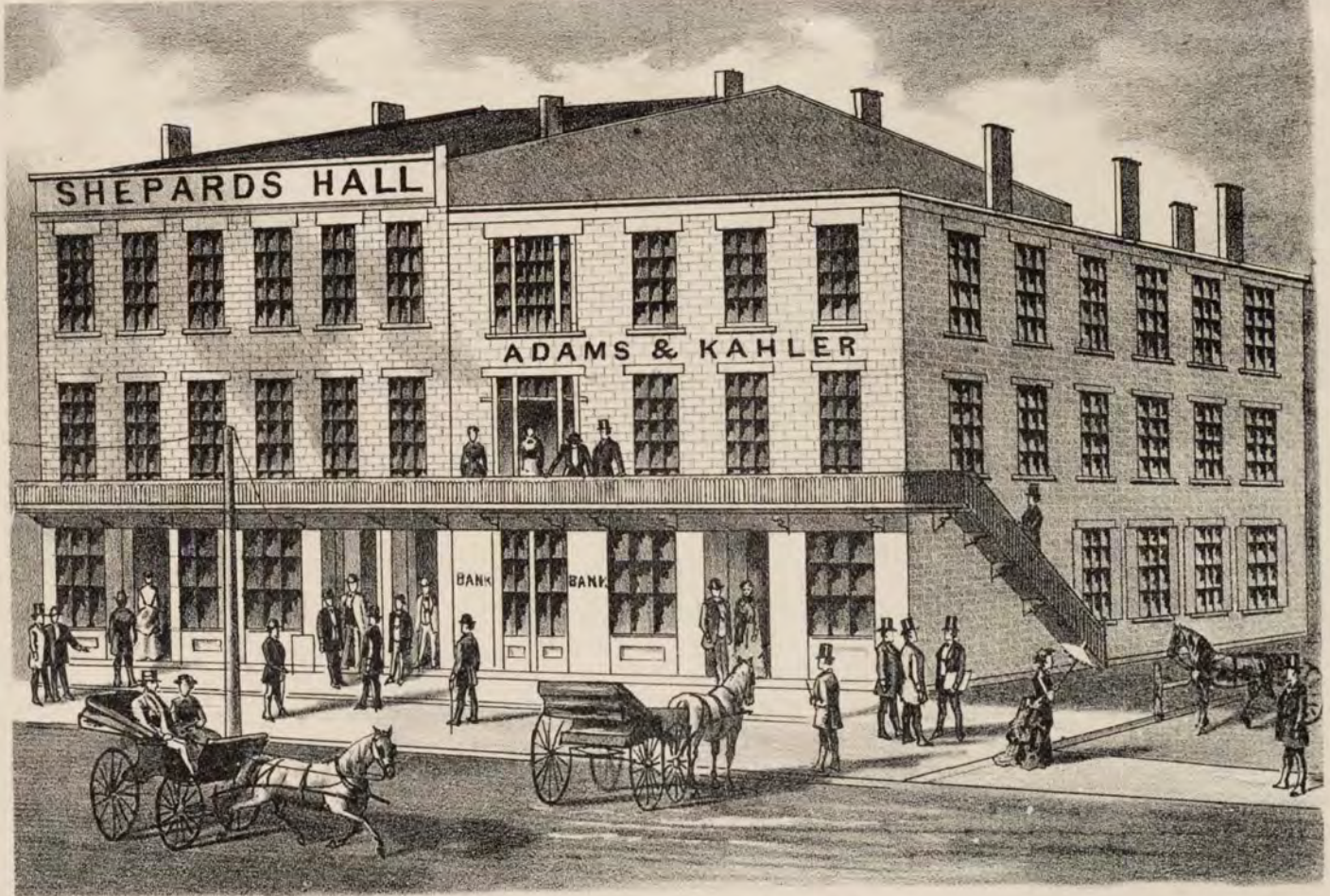




MAPLE GROVE FARM. 600 Acres.

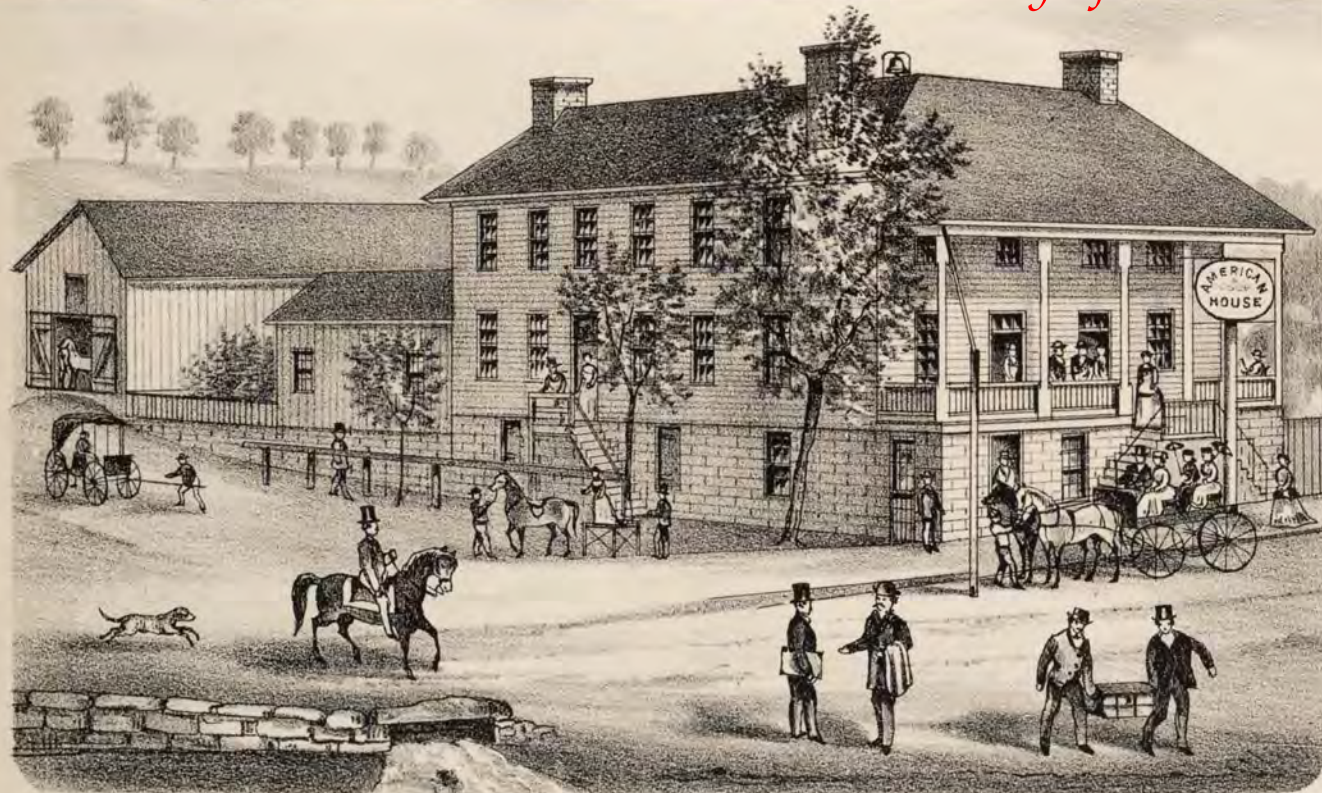

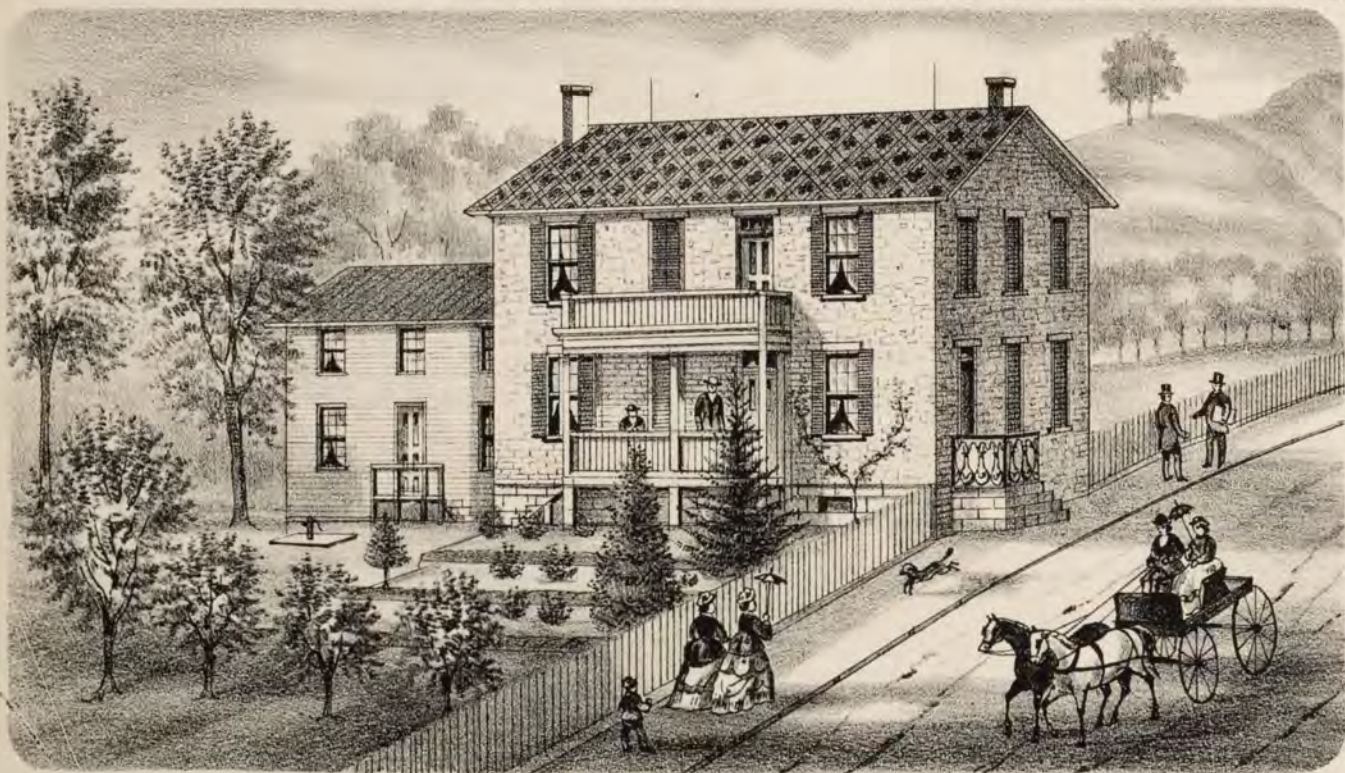

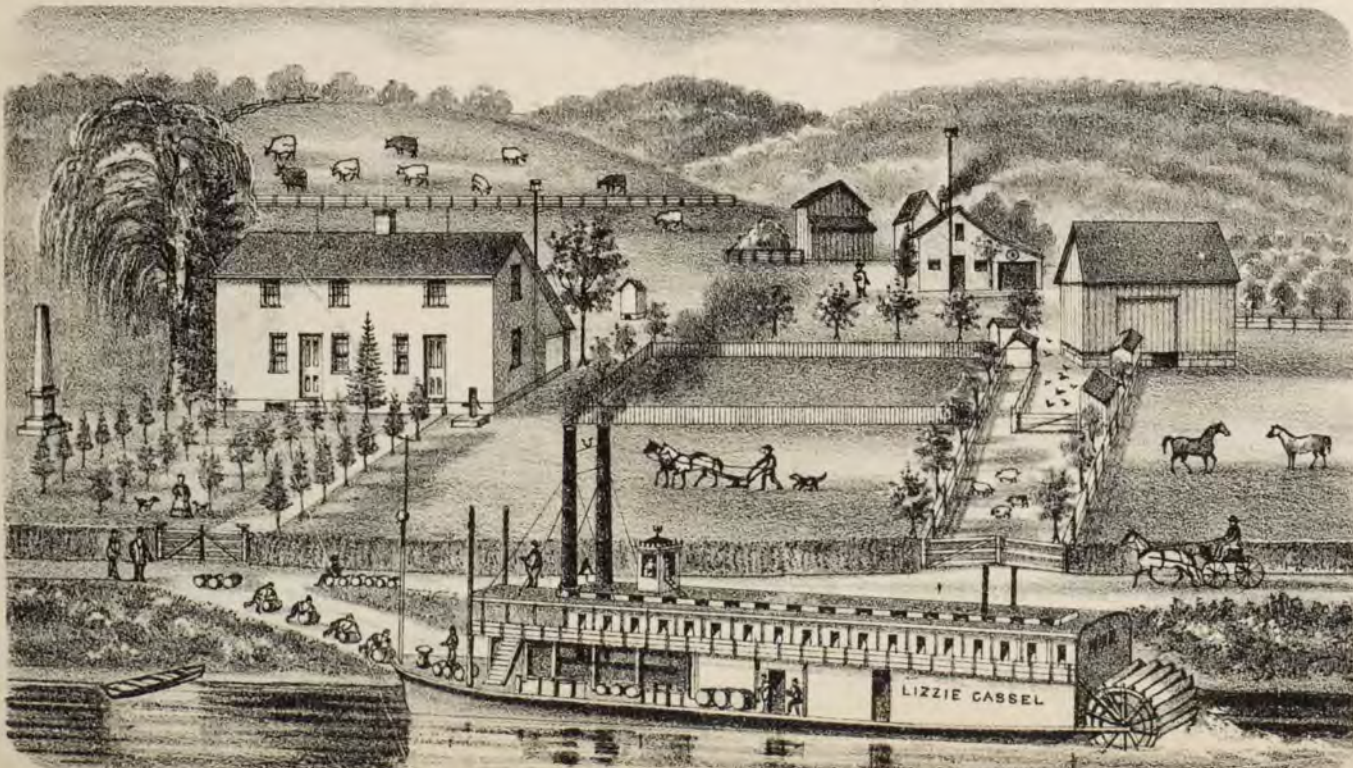

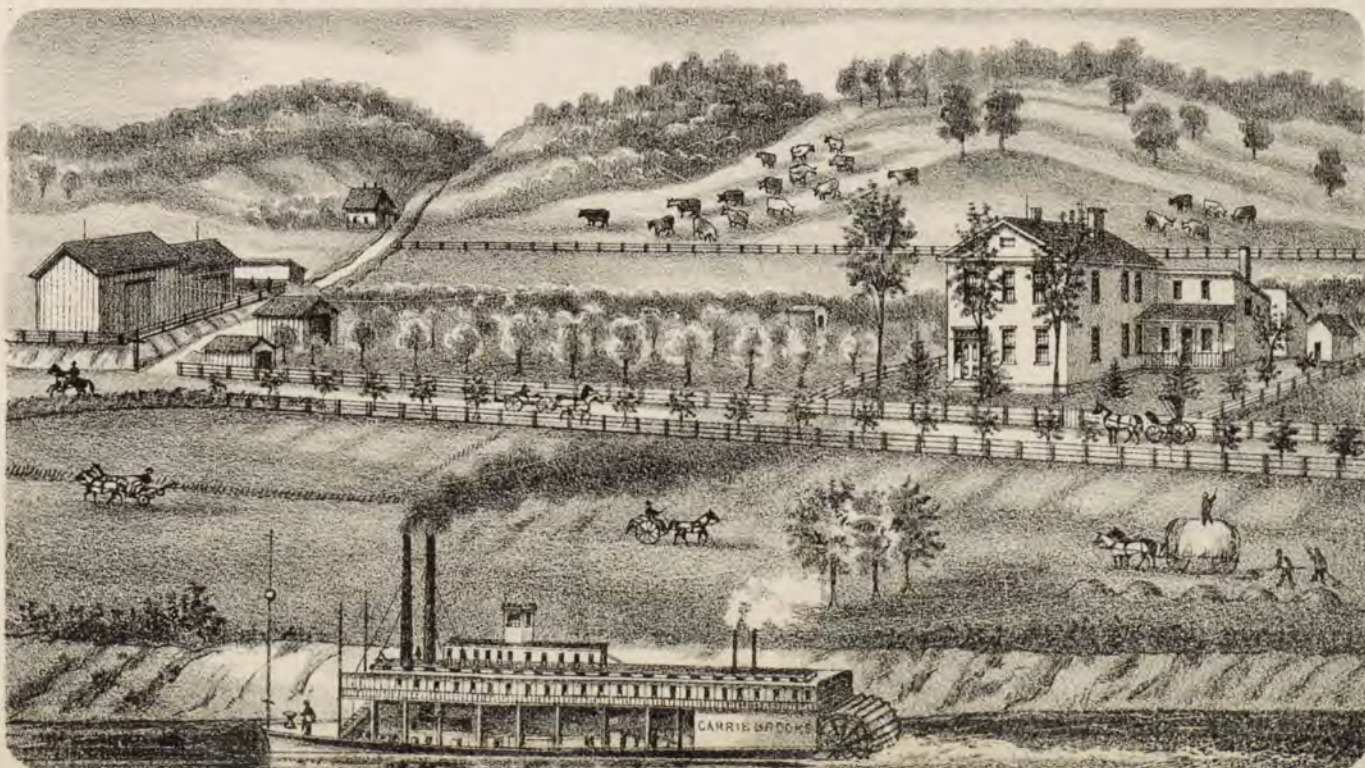
RESIDENCE OF H. DUNSMOOR, MALTA, OHIO.

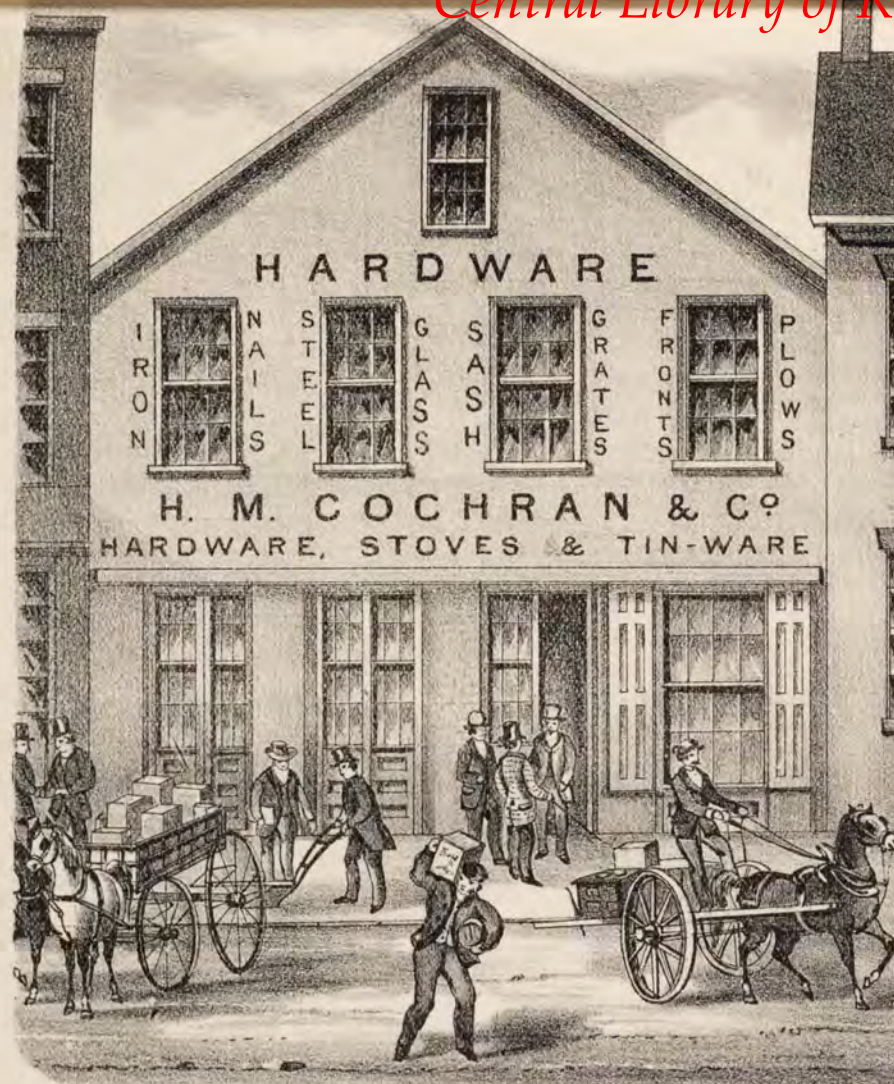
FARM AND RESIDENCE OF O. BROKAW, WINDSOR TWP. MONROE COUNTY, OHIO

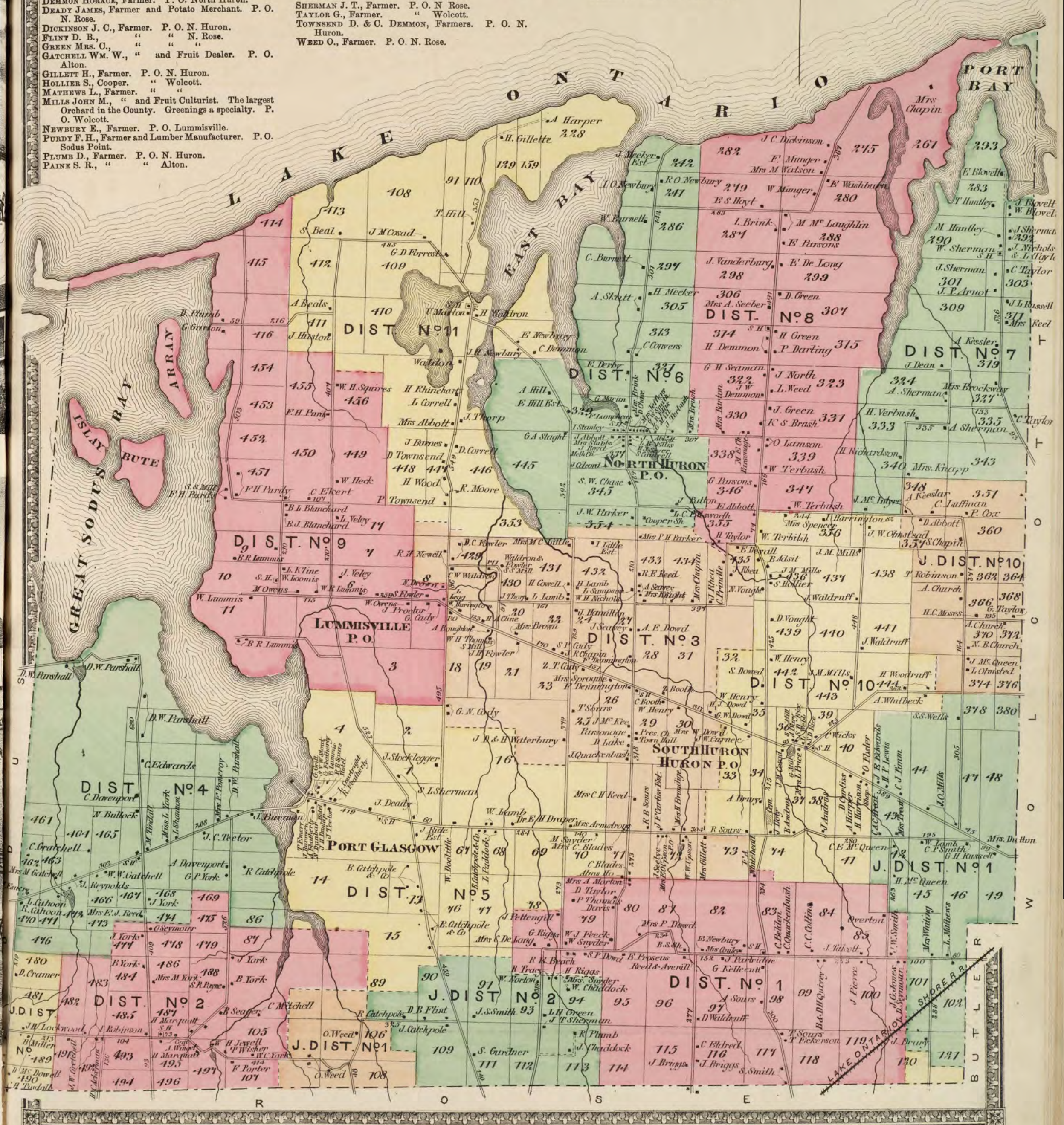

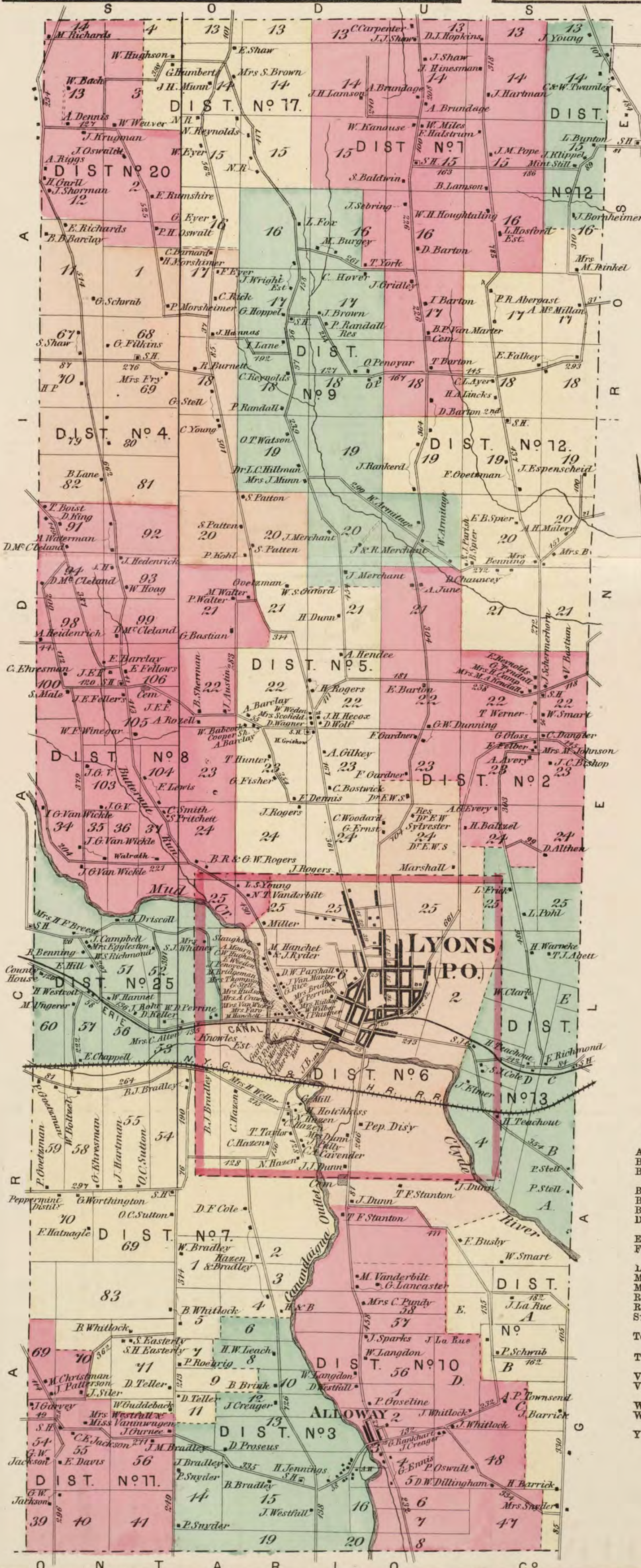
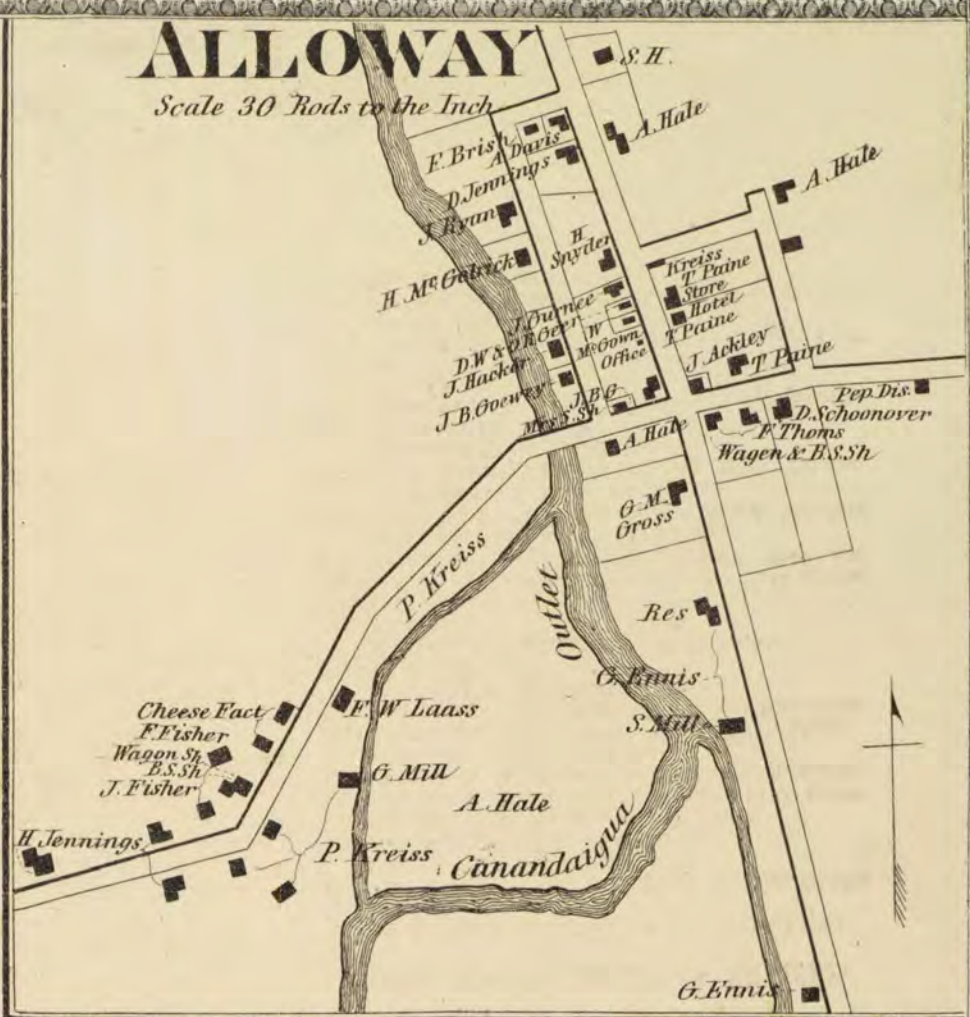

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH OF J. W. WHITE, M.D., DECEASED.

Dr. J. W. WHITE, who is well worthy of mention as a prominent citizen of Morgan County, was born in Marietta, Washington Co., Ohio, on the 3d day of November, 1819. His parents, who were well-to-do farmers, removed to Windsor township, this county, in the year 1825, locating on a tract of land situated in what is known as "Big Bottom." More than usual care was bestowed upon the early education of the Doctor, his parents designing him for the Ministry, and with that end in view he "finished" at Oberlin College. Thinking, however, that the profession of Medicine afforded a wider scope, and that in the role of a physician he could as greatly benefit mankind, he studied medicine with Dr. James Bell as preceptor, and graduated at the Cleveland Medical College, winter term of 1848. Returning to Windsor soon after receiving his diploma, he began the practice of his profession, which he pursued with eminent success until 1867, when he "retired." In 1849 he became a member of the Masonic order at Corinthian Lodge No. 111, McConnellsville, remained as such until 1854, when he withdrew to become 1st Master of Webb Lodge, No. 252 (instituted at Stockport October 18, 1854), serving in that capacity for several years with "honor to himself and credit to the fraternity," remaining zealously attached to the order until his death, which occurred February 2d, 1875. His funeral, which was conducted under the auspices of the order, was largely attended, many prominent Masons of the county participating in the ceremonies. The fine portrait of the Doctor which appears in this volume will be readily recognized, and from it may be traced his real character. Energy, solidity, and integrity formed its basis; and though by nature impetuous and high spirited, yet having these passions entirely under control, he had in his associations acquired a reputation for amiability and kindness, gaining him hosts of warm friends; and being strongly Republican in politics, he wielded a powerful influence in his immediate vicinity.

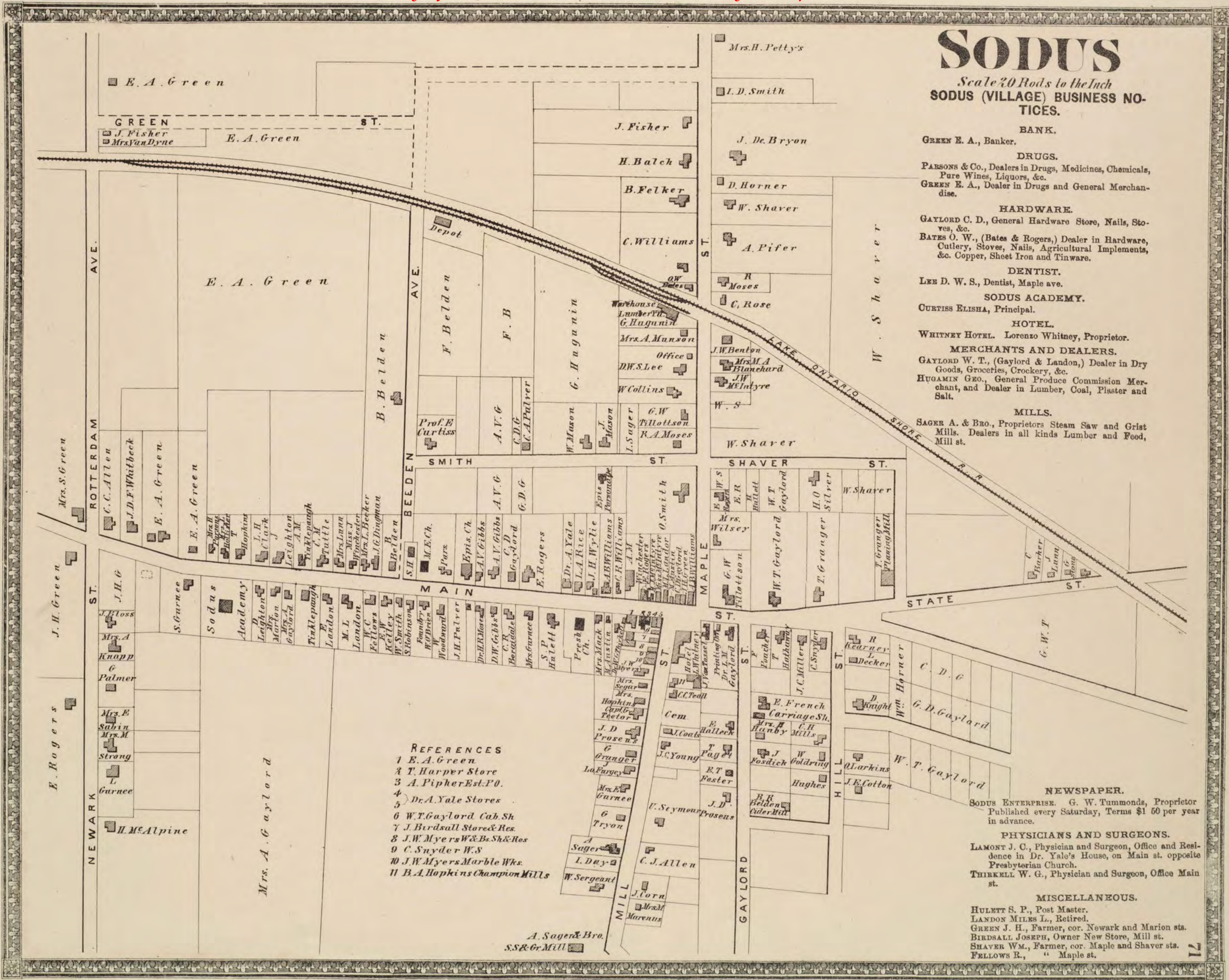
