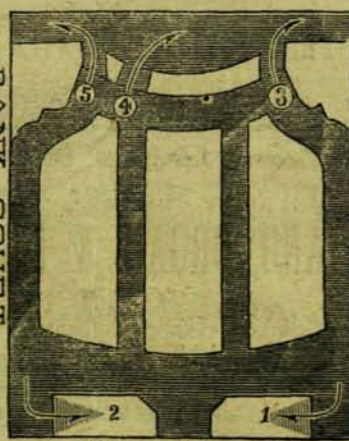

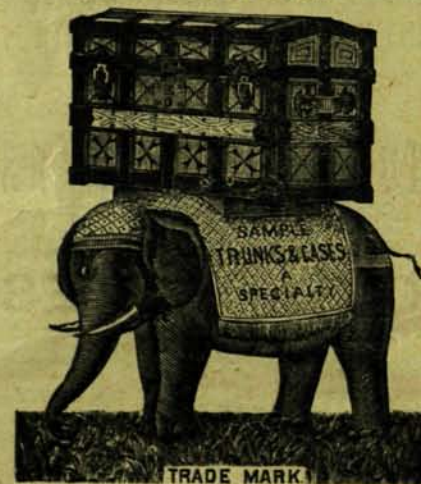

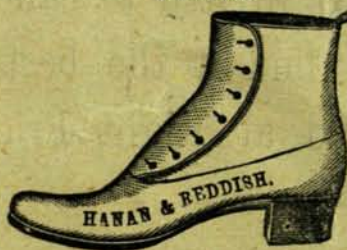
BETWEEN THE ACTS.

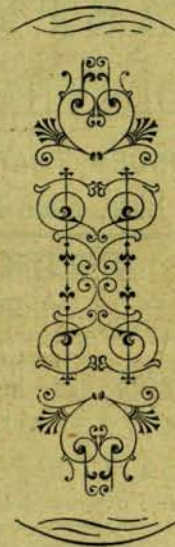
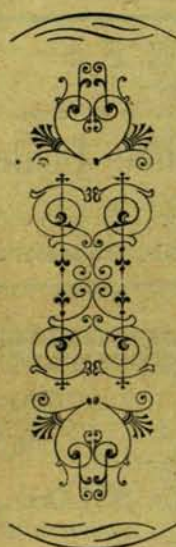
