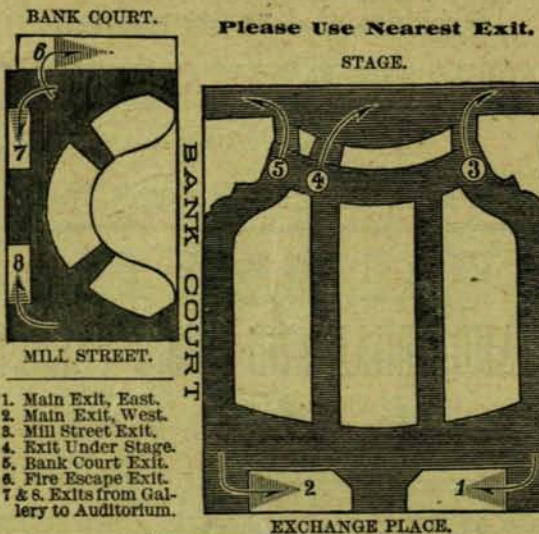

—This drama will be presented at the Corinthian Academy of Music, on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday evenings and Wednesday matinee, September 25th, 26th and 27th, with Miss Agnes Herndon, the beautiful Southern Star, in the role of THE ADVENTRESS. The N. Y. Tribune says: "Only a Farmer's Daughter," by Elliott Barnes, was presented last night with great success. It is a peculiar drama, bold in its portrayal of wickedness, yet thrillingly interesting. An old farmer has a beautiful daughter, who is beloved by an author who marries her and vows to protect and cherish her until death. Ten years afterward the author has grown famous and rich. An adventress, in the guise of the widow of a French General, invades the household, and, with the aid of a male accomplice, succeeds in alienating the husband and wife, slays the wife and child, gets possession of the husband and his money, is slain by the latter and fills a pauper's grave. That is the way the drama seems to come out, but the last scene shows that all the events after the entrance of the adventress into the action are the figurants of a dream. But the dream cures the author. In the working out of the plot the action is admirable, though very bold, and the audience followed the development with keen interest.

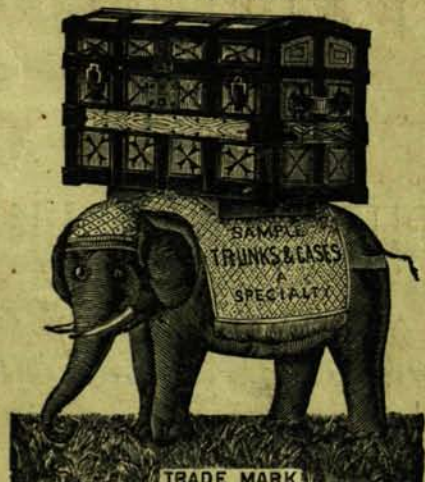
