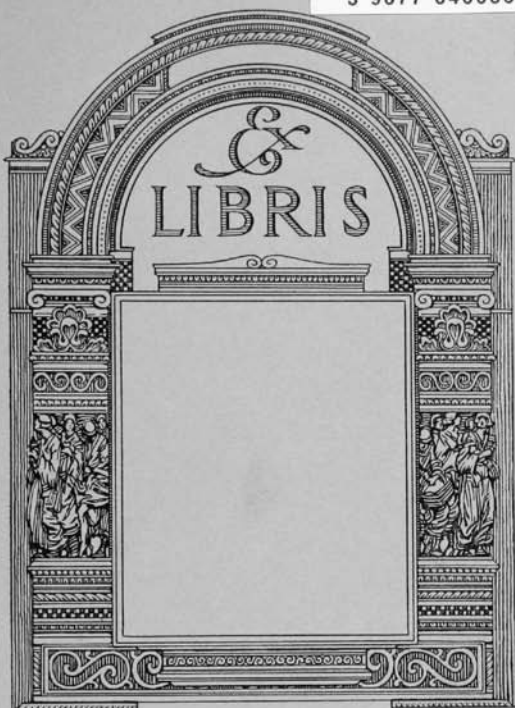

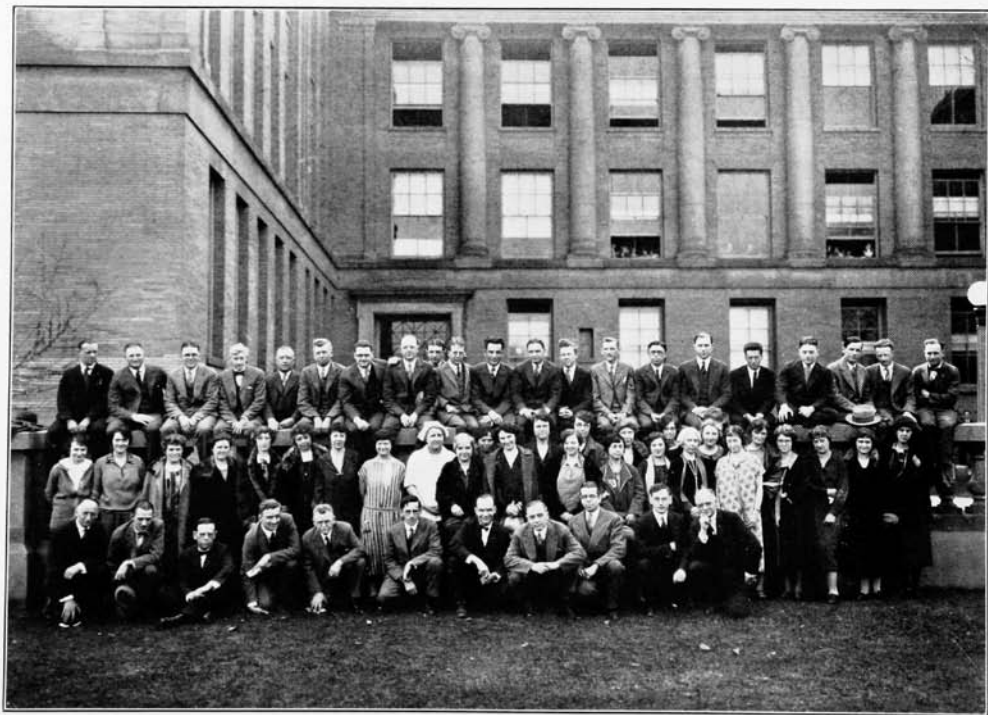

*Fifth:* To the manager of the next senior play, we leave the plumbing fixtures used in our Senior Farce, "The Piper."

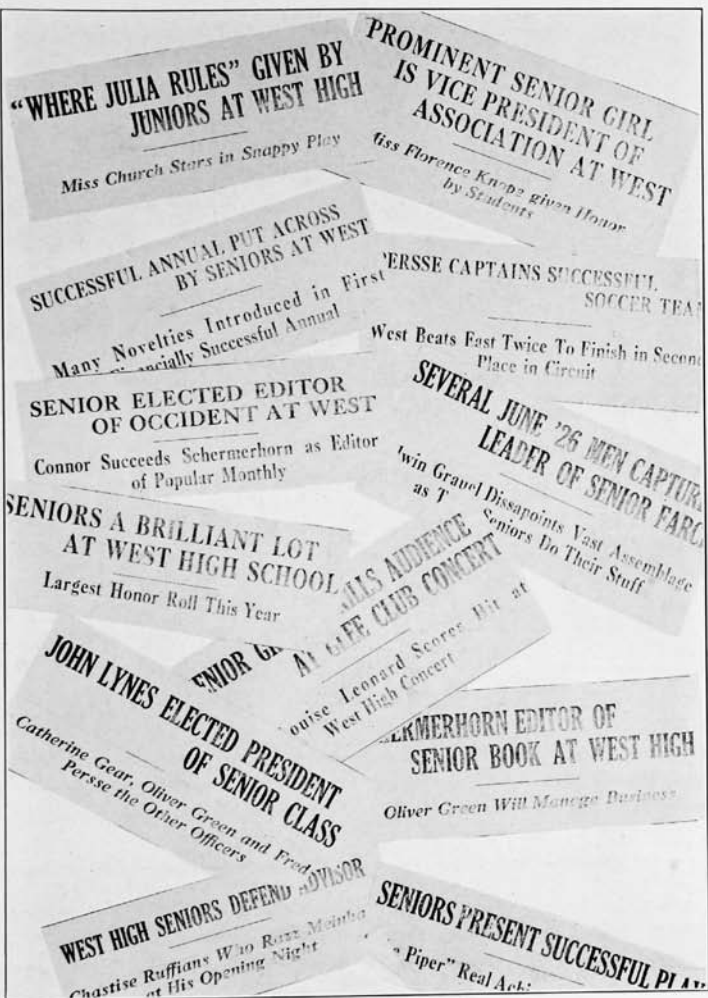
*Sixth:* To Coach Tichenor we leave a few of our number who have fallen by the wayside that they may bolster up his ranks for next year.
