LEGAL HOLIDAYS.

It will be seen from the following act, that when a holiday occurs on a week day, the law treats it as a Sunday for all purposes connected with the payment, acceptance, or protest of bills of exchange and promissory notes. All notes maturing on such days, therefore, must be paid the day before, or, if that is Sunday, the Saturday previous. But when these holidays fall on Sunday, then the next day is also a legal holiday; but the law interposes in favor of the debtors, and allows payment of notes, etc., made after March 16, 1865, to be deferred to the Tuesday succeeding. The following is the bill passed March 18, 1865, chap. 1846:

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The act entitled "An act to designate the holidays to be observed in the acceptance and payment of bills of exchange and promissory notes," passed April fourth, eighteen hundred and forty-nine, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

§ 1. The following days, viz.: Any day appointed or recommended by the Governor of this State or the President of the United States, as a day of fast or thanksgiving, the fourth day of July, twenty-fifth day of December, commonly called Christmas day, the first day of January, commonly called New Year's day, and the twenty-second day of February, and when the said fourth day of July, twenty-fifth day of December, first day of January, or twenty-second day of February shall occur on Sunday, then the ensuing day thereto, shall, for all purposes whatsoever, as regards the presenting for payment or acceptance, and of the protesting and giving notice of the dishonor of bills of exchange, bank checks and promissory notes, made after the passage of this act, be treated and considered as the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday. And any bill of exchange, bank check or promissory note, made after the passage of this act, which but for this act would fall due and payable on any of the days herein mentioned, shall, when said day falls on Sunday, become payable on the Tuesday next succeeding such days.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of August next.
