# RATES OF POSTAGE

## DOMESTIC POSTAGE RATES

### First Class

Letters, etc.: 3 cents for each ounce or fraction of an ounce. Letters addressed for local delivery 3 cents each ounce or fraction of an ounce.

Post Cards: 1 cent each, within prescribed sizes.

Business Reply Cards: Ordinary, 2 cents each; air mail, 9 cents per ounce.

Business Reply Envelopes: Ordinary 1 cent in addition to regular postage. Apply at P O for permit.

### Second Class

Newspapers and Periodicals (Transient rate): 1 cent for each 3 ounces or fraction of 3 ounces or fourth-class rate whichever is lower.

### Third Class

Printed Circulars: Books having less than 24 pages, catalogs, merchandise, miscellaneous printed matter, (except first and second class), weighing 3 ounces or less, 15 cents for each 3 ounces or fraction.

Books: Printed of 24 or more pages, seeds, bulbs, plants, cuttings, etc: 1 cent for each 3 ounces or fraction.

\*Book Rate: 3 cents a pound plus certain extra, applies to certain types of books which are permanently bound by stitching or stapling, or by means of spiral or plastic binding, when covered with paper, cloth, leather or other substantial material, such as music books, a view book or atlas, bibles, etc. Books mailed under this rate must be indorsed by the mailers "Book" or "Books".

\*Consult Post Office concerning books mailable under this rate.

The rates of postage on individually addressed catalogs and similar printed advertising matter in bound form, consisting of 24 or more pages and not exceeding 10 pounds in weight, shall be as follows:

The rates do not apply to bulk parcels containing a number of pieces sent to one address. It will be permissible to include with catalogs and other printed advertising matter mailed at these new rates the usual loose inclosures, such as order forms, reply envelopes, loose circulars, etc., provided, such inclosures are incidental. Matter mailed under the provisions of the new regulation should be clearly indorsed in order to distinguish the same from other fourth-class mail and prevent rating such matters with deficient postage at the regular fourth-class rate. These rates do not apply to packages weighing 3 ounces or less, that is, third-class matter.

### FOURTH CLASS—PARCEL POST

Fourth Class: Includes printed matter, merchandise and all other matter weighing in excess of 3 ounces except first and second class matter. Parcels limited to 100 inches, length and girth combined.

Weight limit 70 pounds. Insure all valuable parcels. For quick delivery, send Special Delivery and Special Delivery air mail.

Library Books: First, Second and Third Zones, and State, 4 cents for first pound or fraction, 1 cent each additional pound or fraction.

Note—On parcels for delivery in first and second zones where shortest practicable mail route is 300 miles or more, the rate is 5 cents for first pound and 2 cents for each additional pound.

C. O. D. Delivery service is applicable to third and fourth class mail and sealed matter of any class bearing postage at the first class rate. Collections up to \$200.

### General Instructions

Pack well—wrap securely—address plainly. Show name of sender and complete address with zone number. Fragile and perishable matter should be so marked.

### AIR MAIL INFORMATION

Eight cents for each ounce or fraction thereof. Air mail can be insured, registered, sent C O D or special delivery when the additional fees are prepaid. It may be deposited in any mail box, but must be indorsed "VIA AIR MAIL" underneath the postage stamp immediately above the address. Letters sent via air mail to members of the armed forces at certain addresses, six cents per half ounce.

Additional duplicate receipts may be obtained upon payment of 1 cent each.

Prepay postage fully on all letters and parcels.

Always address mail for city delivery to street and zone number and zone number and request correspondents to do likewise.

Use designation North or South, East or West when it is a proper part of the address and save delay in delivery.

Insure valuable parcels.

Wrap parcel post carefully in heavy paper and tie knots securely.

You will often gain a day's time in delivery by depositing mail as soon as it is ready.
