Mayor Stephen May has urged all senior citizen homeowners in the city with annual incomes below \$6,000 to apply immediately for a 50 per cent cut in their property taxes. The deadline is Friday, Sept. 29, he stressed.

He explained that to qualify for a 50 per cent exemption from the 1973-74 city and school taxes and 1974 county taxes a person must be a city resident who is 65 or over Oct. 1, has owned and lived in his or her home for the last five years and have a total income, including Social Security benefits, below \$6,000. Homeowners must file an application form with the City Bureau of Assessments on the second floor of City Hall, 30 Broad St. W., by Friday, Sept. 29.

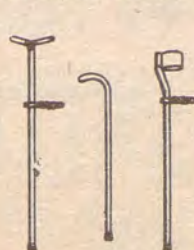

**Increased Social Security Benefits**  
Social Security benefit payments to residents of Monroe and Livingston counties will be increased by a total of over 29 million dollars in calendar year 1973 as a result of the 20 percent benefit increase passed by Congress and signed into law by President Nixon on July 1, Janet Shupp Social Security District Office Manager, said. The Rochester district office services residents of both Monroe and Livingston Counties. The first checks to include the 20 percent increase will reach beneficiaries in the Rochester area on Oct. 3, the regular date for the delivery of checks covering benefits for September - the month for which the increase is effective. Beneficiaries need not take any action because the increase will come to them automatically.
