Certificates of work done in English and Business Course, given at close of first year if desired.
- (e) No subjects in advance of the student's current year may be taken.







Roehester Free Academy.

Early in the forties the idea was first suggested in this city, which finally developed into the modern high school system, but it was not until Sept., 1857, that the Central High School organized, and five years later this institution was admitted by the Regents as the Rochester Free Academy.

Yet as far back as March 15, 1827, a school known as the Rochester High School, No. 2, was chartered and was admitted to the University of the State of New York in 1831. This school according to the Regents' Centennial Report, grew into the Rochester Free Academy.

The present building was erected in 1873, at a cost of about \$130,000.






