Here he lies upon the lap of Time A youth, to students of the present unknown; Fair West High gave his life a rhyme, And oblivion claimed him for her own.


Large was his bounty, his school spirit sincere; Heaven did a recompense as largely send: For, tho he knows it not, to this year His presence hovers in the school, and to the end


